

Ankara Atatürk Lisesi Model United Nations Code of Conduct

Standards of Conduct

1. Upholding Decorum and Professionalism

1.1. Delegates are expected to uphold the decorum and professionalism of the Ankara Atatürk Lisesi Model United Nations (MUNAAL) conference by adhering to the guidelines outlined in this Code of Conduct.

1.2. All delegates must thoroughly read and adhere to this code for the entire duration of the conference. Failure to comply may result in dismissal from the conference and/or disqualification from events or awards.

2. Professional Conduct

2.1. Delegates are required to maintain professional behavior at all times. Disruptive or over-intoxicated delegates will be asked to leave the conference, and they will not qualify for awards.

2.2. MUNAAL reserves the right to remove delegates from events or transportation if found to be disruptive of the general flow of the conference.

3. Substance Abuse Policy

3.1. MUNAAL has a zero-tolerance policy for the illegal use of drugs and alcohol. Consumption of alcohol by persons under the age of 18 is strictly prohibited.

3.2. Violations of this policy will be reported to the secretariat immediately. The Secretariat can use its discretion to remove a participant from the event and take immediate action.

4. Smoking Policies

4.1. Smoking is prohibited inside all buildings and within 25 feet of any building, following MUNAAL and College Policies.

4.2. Delegates must respect Ankara Atatürk Lisesi's smoking policies for individual rooms.

5. Photography Consent

5.1. Delegates, by signing up for MUNAAL, agree to be photographed by MUNAAL staffers for future conferences and promotional material.

5.2. Delegates may inform the secretariat if they prefer not to have their pictures taken.

6. Dress Code

6.1. Delegates must adhere to Western business attire, maintaining an appropriate and professional appearance.

6.2. Participants who wear informal attire and inappropriate apparel will get a vocal or a written warning submitted from the Secretariat.

6.3. Failure to abide by the dress code may result in being asked to leave the conference.

7. Anti-Harassment Policy

2.7.1. Any form of harassment, including racism and sexism, will not be tolerated.

7.2. Delegates engaging in such activities will be disqualified from awards and reported to their advisors.

8. Sexual Harassment and Violence

8.1. Sexual harassment or violence is strictly prohibited, and offenders will be disqualified and dismissed from MUNAAL.

9. Unacceptable Behavior

9.1. The Secretariat reserves the right to expel delegates for unacceptable behavior, including vulgar language, gestures, or inappropriate actions.

10. Mobile Devices

10.1. Cell phones must be silent during committee sessions, and electronic devices may be used outside the committee room if necessary.

10.2. Delegates with emergencies requiring phone use during committee sessions should inform the committee presidency.

11. Venue Policies

11.1. Anfa Fuar ve Kongre Merkezi reserves the right to ask delegates to leave for unacceptable behavior, with damages being the responsibility of the student or delegation.

12. Sportsmanship

12.1. Delegates must act at all times in accordance with good sportsmanship and fair play.

13. Artificial Intelligence Usage

13.1. Delegates are prohibited from using any sort of artificial intelligence on any of the documents written before or during the conference dates.

13.2. Any detection or usage of Artificial Intelligence to conduct plagiarism will result in immediate action by the secretariat.

14. Allocation policy

14.1 Each participant of the conference shall send the required documents after they are informed that they are accepted to the conference, if they fail to do so Ankara Atatürk Lisesi Model United Nations Executive reserves the right to eject the individual from their positions.

14.2. Ankara Atatürk Lisesi Model United Nations secretariat reserves the right to alter, add, or change the allocations that the participants have preferred at their application.

15. Honor Code

15.1. Delegates are bound by the Ankara Atatürk Lisesi Honor Code, pledging not to lie, cheat, or steal within the conference.

15.2. Delegates are also bound by the policies of their respective schools and their advisors.
